

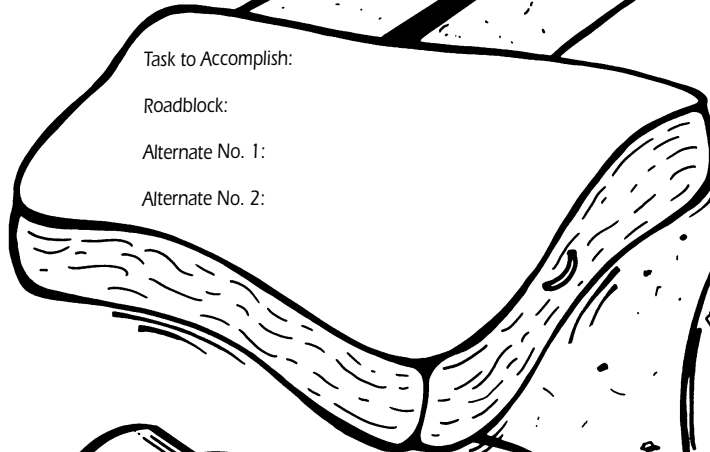


# Getting Around Roadblocks



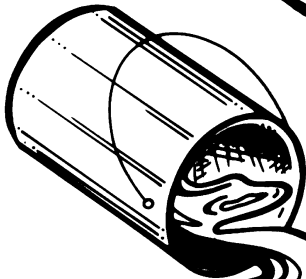
Identifying a roadblock is the first step toward solving a problem. If the roadblock can't be removed, find an alternate route to the solution.

 Alternate No. 2: Ask the professor if you can meet the requirement through independent study.

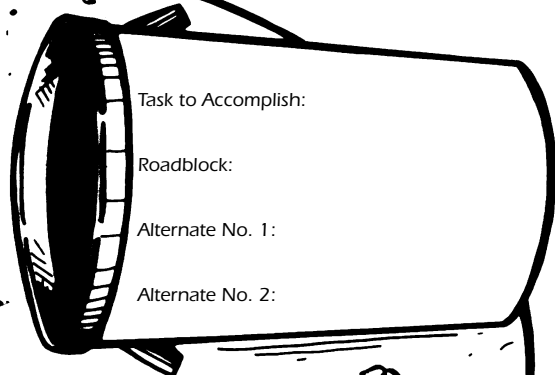
